Established more than 25 years ago, Mainstreet Waynesboro, Inc. (MSW) works to revitalize our downtown district in a variety of ways, such as providing support for new and existing businesses, beautification projects and hosting events and activities to attract visitors from outside of the area. We work to instill a sense



of pride and provide opportunities for enjoyment for all.

A Well-Rounded Downtown

Mainstreet Waynesboro strives to make downtown fun, safe, vibrant and diverse. One of the ways we accomplish that goal is to organize and host events that bring people downtown to see our shops, restaurants and brew pub while also raising money for the organization.

In 2024, we attracted thousands of people to our car and truck show, Waynesboro Wizarding Weekend and Market Day events along with Chocolate Excursion. In addition, we held our third Holiday Sip & Stroll, our Downtown Food Stroll, and summer concerts at Main





Street Park. We also started First Friday events and held one of our most popular events yet: A Taylor Swift-themed fan activity called Meet Me on Main Street.

We continue to organize the popular Christmas activities in our downtown, including the Tree Lighting Ceremony, Christmas Parade, holiday market and New Year's Eve Boro Blast.

Beautiful by Design

Mainstreet Waynesboro is tasked with keeping our downtown as safe, clean and green as possible.

Mainstreet raises the funds for the beautiful flower baskets and large planters that line Main Street each year, and we maintain the Welcome to Waynesboro signs at each entrance to town.

In early 2024, we pushed forward

a Safe Clean and Green Campaign that focused on more doggie depot stations, brighter lights, smarter landscaping, cleaner storefronts and safety at our many crosswalks and intersections. We also added a dozen new veterans banners to our annual program to honor our heroes.

MAIN STREET PARK

This beautiful downtown oasis has seen tens of thousands of visitors since it opened in October of 2017. The park has been the site of a bustling farmers market the past seven summers, as well as a home to concerts, vigils,

art shows, Food Truck Fridays, birthday parties, class reunions, weddings, and our Boro Blast celebration.

Market at the Park farmers market continues to drive foot traffic downtown, welcoming more than 14,000 visitors in 2024 and averaging 26 vendors per week.

Most of all, the park is a place to relax with coffee from Brio or Christine's and a book from Wee Scot Book Shoppe.

THE NATIONAL REGISTER

Mainstreet Waynesboro teamed with the State Historic Preservation Office to accomplish a long-time goal: Getting Waynesboro's downtown and surrounding area placed on the National Register of Historic Places. The district includes the core of downtown, from Franklin Street to Clayton Avenue, and Clayton Avenue between Main Street and 5th Street, including adjacent blocks and cross streets.

The designation is a source of pride for Waynesboro, which loves its history, and opens the door for grants and tax incentives for property owners.

LITTLE THINGS MEAN A LOT

Mainstreet Wavnesboro was named a National Main Street America Affiliate Program for the eighth time in nine years and continues to be active on the regional and state levels.

Mainstreet continued several of its most popular programs, including the Downtown Window Story-Walk®, while also creating new ones that focused on partnerships with other non-profits and the Alexander Hamilton Memorial Free Library.

Mainstreet welcomed several new businesses, while relishing the new Nikki's Korean BBQ restaurant. We

also celebrated some serious milestones: Eichholz Flowers turns 130 and TranquilaTEA celebrated its 20th year in business.

We also increased our social media presence to help promote our vibrant downtown.
